

will facilitate the execution of the fearful aims of the Jews. The said 'Ulamas have therefore decided to express their strong protest against this policy which will result in the extermination of Moslems and the disappearance of Islam and to demand that it may be changed and to take firm and drastic steps in this respect.

I now, therefore, submit to Your Excellency some of the resolutions to which the 'Ulamas have decided to ask Your Excellency to give effect :-

- (1) Absolute prohibition of Jewish immigration to this country.
- (2) Allowing without restriction the return of the desirous Arabs of this country, who are in America or elsewhere.
- (3) Making legislation which would stand in the way of land sales and transfers from the Arab inhabitants to non-Arabs.
- (4) Making legislation similar to that of the Five Feddans in Egypt regarding the transfer of lands amongst Arabs themselves in order to safeguard the interests of small owners and cultivators.
- (5) Issuing a general permission enabling Moslems who desire to make their Miri land a Zurri (Family) or a charitable Waqf so to do.
